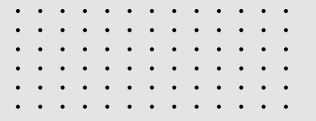

VBF convened its first General Alliance Meeting (GAM) of 2026, with the participation of all VBF Members Chambers.

As a biannual meeting under the VBF governance framework, the General Alliance Meeting provides a platform for Chambers to exchange information, raise business concerns and advocacy priorities, and discuss matters related to the operation and direction of the VBF Alliance.

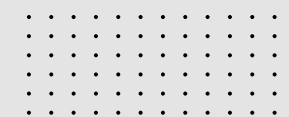
# VBF opens Working Group membership renewal
